Many came into Titanic Foundation's collection through donations from former employees and their families. Others are connected to projects that the Foundation has worked on, such as the development of Titanic Belfast, the restoration of the Harland & Wolff Drawing Offices and preservation of SS Nomadic. Our collection has everything from a 1912 penny to huge steam cranes!
